(hereafter referred to as the "Club"), having its registered address at Hauptstrasse 118, 65760 Eschborn, represented by the members of the board (email address of the president [vorsitzende@tennis65eschborn.de](mailto:vorsitzende@tennis65eschborn.de); email address of the vice president: [vizevorsitzender@tennis65eschborn.de](mailto:vizevorsitzender@tennis65eschborn.de)) stores and processes your personal information and data. This may include title, first name and surname, email address(es), category of membership, tennis pass license and ID number, nationality, date of birth, membership fee, telephone number(s), postal address, bank account details, date of joining, contact details for parents/guardians of Junior members (along with their declaration of consent for the Junior member to participate in activities of the Club), method of payment for membership subscription, and photographs/videos taken at events held at the Club or elsewhere

The aforementioned data is processed in compliance with the provisions of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and used primarily for the purpose of managing your membership and in line with the Club's purpose to promote tennis sports.

The data is protected and only the Club's members of the board have access to it. Data is transferred to external parties solely for the performance of contractual obligations such as the registration of teams or individual members for tennis tournaments. Data is processed and stored as long as it is necessary for the performance of the Club's contractual obligations. If the data are no longer required for the performance of the Club's contractual obligations, they are regularly deleted in accordance with applicable record retention periods which are typically 10 years.

Every data subject has a right of access (article 15 GDPR), a right to rectification (article 16 GDPR), a right to erasure (article 17 GDPR), a right to restriction of processing (article 18 GDPR), a right to object (article 21 GDPR) and a right to data portability (article 20 GDPR).

You may revoke your consent to the processing of personal data at any time. This also applies to the revocation of declarations of consent that are granted prior to the entry into force of the EU General Data Protection Regulation, i.e. prior to 25 May 2018. Please be advised that the revocation will only take effect in the future. Any processing that was carried out prior to the revocation shall not be affected thereby.
